# Angels school take top honours

**Bangalore:** Angels English High School, Munishwara Nagar rallied superbly to beat ASC School and College 2-1 to win the Bangalore leg of the Tata Tea Arsenal Soccer stars tournament here on Monday.

In a thrilling final, which saw end-to-end action, the Army boys took an early lead, but Angels slowly clawed their way back restoring parity in the first half itself.

The start of the second half saw Angel snatch the lead and withstood all the raids by ASC boys. Angels keeper Janardhan brought off some splendid saves which won him the best

goalkeeper award. Karthikeyan D, a Xth standard student of Vidya Niketan High School, Domlur, won the Most Valuable Player award.

Earlier, in the semifinals, ASC defeated St Josephs Boys HS while Angels pipped Presidency Church School.

The two-day tournament, the first of several legs spread all over the country, saw 48 schools taking part. The national finals, for which both the finalists have qualified, will be held in Kolkata in May.

Two players from each of the legs will also be called for a camp in Kolkata from which a group of 15 will be picked for a trip to Arsenal.
