

Govt Model-36 wins football trophy

CHANDIGARH: Government Model School, Sector 36, outplayed St Stephen's School, Sector 45, 7-0 in the Tata Tea Jaago Re Inter-Milan Soccer Stars Tournament (Chandigarh Zone) at the Sector 17 Football Stadium here on Tuesday.

For Vivek High School, Mohit scored the consolation goal.
