

# BAKSHA BN WIN FOOTBALL TALENT HUNT

**KOLKATA:** Baksha BN Vidyalay won the city leg of the Tata Tea Jaago Re Inter Milan Soccer Stars meet beating Aharampur Sahara Boys' School 1-0 in the final here on Tuesday.

Supriyo Mazumdar scored the winner and was included in the final squad of 30 to be trained at a camp here.

The winners of the city leg will take part in the nationwide finals to be held in Shillong in April. The under-15 football talent hunt will cover nine more cities across the country.

After the finals, the squad of 30 players from different cities will train under coaches from Inter Milan's football academy before some of them are sent to the Italian club.

Till last year, the initiative had a tie-up with English club Arsenal. The Indian team won the under-15 tournament at the Arsenal Football Festival last August.
